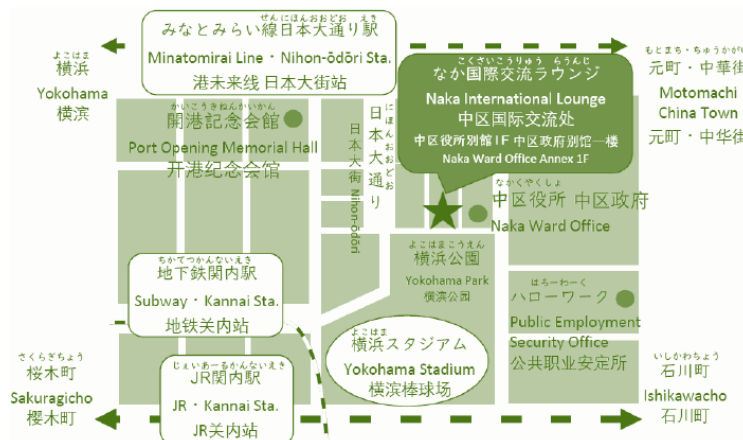
Instructor
